

QUALIFICATION SHOOT

Unit Standard 123513 - Demonstrate Tactical Proficiency with a Handgun

In order to be declared competent against this Unit Standard you are required to pass the following Qualification Shoot:

Shoot 1

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
5m	Standing	5	6 seconds	1 x A4
The pistol is presented from the holster and 5 rounds are to be fired in a time of 6 seconds				

Shoot 2

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
5m	Kneeling	5	6 seconds	1 x A4

The pistol is presented from the holster, you will then go to the kneeling position and fire 5 rounds in a time of 6 seconds.

Shoot 3

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
5m	Standing	5	8 seconds	1 x A4

The pistol is presented from the holster with the strong hand. The pistol will then be transferred to the weak hand and 5 rounds will be fired in a time of 8 seconds using the weak hand only.

Shoot 4

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
10m	Standing	10	10 seconds	1 x A4

The pistol is presented from the holster and 10 rounds are fired in a time of 10 seconds. [If a magazine change is required in the case of low capacity firearms, 1 extra second may be added for the magazine change.]

Shoot 5

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
10m	Standing	5+5	20 seconds	1 x A4

With 5 live rounds and 1 dummy round in each magazine, the pistol is presented and all 10 rounds are to be fired in a time of 20 seconds, carrying out the immediate action drills and magazine change when necessary.

Shoot 6

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
15m	Standing and Prone	5 + 10	20 seconds	1 x A4

The pistol is presented from the holster and 5 rounds will be fired from the standing position. You will then go into the prone position and fire 10 rounds. All 15 rounds must be fired in a time of 20 seconds. [If a magazine change is required in the case of low capacity firearms, 1 extra second may be added for the magazine change.]

Notes

- 1. Every scenario is to begin with the firearm loaded to a safe carry condition applicabe to normal everyday carry.
- 2. The firearm is to be presented from a holster that is securely attached to the person and which complies with legal requirements.

Please note that this is a final summative assessment to be completed after training at the end of the course. The learner is to complete the entire qualification shoot exercise unassisted. This means that the learner is to perform all activities themselves which will include, but is not limited to, loading and unloading, use of PPE, adherence to range rules, range commands and safety procedures.
