

Unit Standard 123520 - Supervise Firearm Training Handgun

In order to be declared competent against this Unit Standard you are required to pass the following Qualification Shoot:

Target is hit accurately with control of bullet impact and accountability for 80% of shots fired. I.e. to be declared competent the learner must achieve 40 out of 50. Accurately means 80% of shots fired must appear on the target. The term accountability refers to the accuracy of the shots fired. The handgun must be fired with two hands, but may not be dead-rested. Each shot on the target counts as 2 points.

Shoot 1

You will draw and fire 5 rounds in a time of 8 seconds at 1 target [Left target].					

Shoot 2

You draw, go to a kneeling position and fire 5 rounds in a time of 8 seconds [Left target].

Shoot 3

You will draw and fire 10 rounds in a time of 10 seconds at 1 target [Right target].					

Shoot 4

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
10m	Standing	10	10 seconds	2 x A4
Volumill draw and fire and fire 1 shot on each target until all 10 rounds have been used in a time of 10 accords [Alternating				

You will draw and fire and fire 1 shot on each target, until all 10 rounds have been used in a time of 10 seconds [Alternating between targets].

Shoot 5

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
10m	Standing	1035	20 seconds	1 x A4

You will start with 5 live rounds and 1 dummy round in each magazine. Your dummy round may not be the first or the last round in the magazine. You will draw and fire 10 rounds in a time of 20 seconds, carrying out the immediate actions drills and magazine changes when necessary. [Left target]

Shoot 6

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
15m	Standing	10	15 seconds	1 x A4

You will draw and fire 10 rounds in 15 seconds at 1 target from a distance of 15 meters. [No dummy rounds, using only one magazine]. [Right target].

Notes

- 1. Every scenario is to begin with the firearm loaded to a safe carry condition applicabe to normal everyday carry.
- 2. The firearm is to be presented from a holster that is securely attached to the person and which complies with legal requirements.

Please note that this is a final summative assessment to be completed after training at the end of the course. The learner is to complete the entire qualification shoot exercise unassisted. This means that the learner is to perform all activities themselves which will include, but is not limited to, loading and unloading, use of PPE, adherence to range rules, range commands and safety procedures.



Unit Standard 123520 - Supervise Firearm Training Shotgun

In order to be declared competent against this Unit Standard you are required to pass the following Qualification Shoot:

Target is hit accurately with control of bullet impact and accountability for 80% of shots fired. Each target counts 5 points which means you can only miss a total of 4 shots.

Shorter Advanced Level Shoots

Exercise 3 is the most difficult of the 4 shoots. If a member can complete this shoot two times consecutively scoring 100% each time, this shall constitute an advanced level pass.

Shoot 1

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
10m	Standing	5	10 seconds	5 x no larger than A5

You will start with the shotgun slung over the weak shoulder, muzzle down. You will present the shotgun and fire 5 shots in a time of 10 seconds.

Shoot 2

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
10m	Standing	4 + 1	12 seconds	5 x no larger than A5

You will start with the shotgun slung over the weak shoulder, muzzle down, loaded with 4 live rounds in the magazine tube [Chamber empty]. You will present the shotgun, fire 4 rounds, reload and fire the last round in a time of 12 seconds.

Shoot 3

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
10m	Standing	3 + 2	15 seconds	5 x no larger than A5

You will start with an unloaded shotgun in your gun hand [High-port position]. 3 rounds are to be loaded when the exercise begins. The ammunition may be held in the weak hand. You will load and fire 3 rounds, reload and fire 2 rounds in a time of 15 seconds.

Shoot 4

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
10m	Standing	2+3	20 seconds	5 x no larger than A5

You will start with an unloaded shotgun in your gun hand [High-port position]. 2 rounds are to be loaded when the exercise begins. You will fire 1 round, reload the remaining 3 rounds while holding the shotgun in the shoulder and aiming at target 2. Fire the 4 remaining shots.

- 1. Every scenario is to begin with the firearm loaded to a safe carry condition applicabe to normal everyday carry.
- 2. The firearm is to be presented from a holster that is securely attached to the person and which complies with legal requirements.

This means that the learner is to perform all activities themselves which will include, but is not limited to, loading and unloading, use of PPE, adherence to range rules, range commands and safety procedures.





Unit Standard 123520 - Supervise Firearm Training Self-Loading Rifle or Carbine

In order to be declared competent against this Unit Standard you are required to pass the following Qualification Shoot. Scoring and marking shall be the same as explained on the Handgun Shoot. The following scoring system shall apply:

Target is hit accurately with control of bullet impact and accountability for 80% of shots fired. I.e. to be declared competent the learner must achieve 40 out of 50. Accurately means 80% of shots fired must appear on the target. The term accountability refers to the accuracy of the shots fired. The self-loading rifle or carbine must be fired with two hands, but may not be dead-rested.

Shoot 1

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
10m	Standing	5	8 seconds	1 x A4

The firearm is presented and 5 rounds are fired. All 5 rounds must be fired in a time of 8 seconds.

Shoot 2

10m	Kneeling	5	8 seconds	1 x A4
You will present the firearm and go into a kneeling position. 5 rounds are to be fired in a time of 8 seconds				

Shoot 3

The firearm is fired from the weak shoulder / support shoulder, 5 rounds will be fired in a time of 8 seconds.					

Shoot 4

The firearm is to be presented and 10 rounds are fired. All 10 rounds are to be fired in a time of 10 seconds.				

The firearm is to be presented and 10 rounds are fired. All 10 rounds are to be fired in a time of 10 seconds.

Shoot 5

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
20m	Standing	5 + 5	20 seconds	1 x A4

With 5 live rounds and 1 dummy round in each magazine, the firearm is presented and all 10 rounds are to be fired in a time of 20 seconds, carrying out the immediate action drills and magazine change when necessary.

Shoot 6

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
25m	Standing and Prone	5 + 10	25 seconds	1 x A4

The firearm is presented and 5 rounds will be fired from the standing position. You will then go into the prone position and fire 10 rounds. All 15 rounds must be fired in a time of 25 seconds.

Notes

- 1. The scenario is to begin with the self-loading rifle or carbine loaded to a safe carry condition applicable to normal everyday carry.
- 2. The self-loading rifle or carbine must be fired with two hands, but may not be dead-rested.

Please note that this is a final summative assessment to be completed after training at the end of the course. The learner is to complete the entire qualification shoot exercise unassisted. This means that the learner is to perform all activities themselves which will include loading and unloading, use of PPE, adherence to range rules, range commands and safety procedures.





Unit Standard 123520 - Supervise Firearm Training Manually Operated Rifle or Carbine

In order to be declared competent against this Unit Standard you are required to pass the following Qualification Shoot:

Target is hit accurately with control of bullet impact and accountability for 80% of shots fired. I.e. to be declared competent the learner must achieve 8 out of 10. Accurately means 80% of shots fired must appear on the target. The term accountability refers to the accuracy of the shots fired. The manually operated rifle or carbine must be fired with two hands, but may not be dead-rested. Each shot on the target counts as 1 point [You can only miss a total of 2 shots]. The target used must have a score area the size of an A4 sheet of paper. Any shots outside of this area do not count.

The rifle is presented from the low ready position. 3 Rounds are fired in a time of 10 seconds.				

Shoot 1

The rifle is presented from the low ready position. 3 Rounds are fired in a time of 10 seconds.				

Shoot 1

Distance	Position	No of Shots	Time	Target Size
15m	Standing	4	10 seconds	1 x A4

The rifle is presented from the low ready position and 4 rounds will be fired. All 4 rounds must be fired in a time of 10 seconds.

Notes

1. The scenario is to begin with the manually operated rifle or carbine loaded to a safe carry condition applicable to normal field carry.

This means that the learner is to perform all activities themselves which will include loading and unloading, use of PPE, adherence to range rules, range commands and safety procedures.
